**IMPORTANT NOTICE REGARDING BANK STREET IMPROVEMENT PROJECT
July 15, 2019**

Dear Bank Street Residents and Homeowners,

On Wednesday, July 17th, Bank Street will be closed to all traffic between Chambers Street and Nassau Street from 7 am to 6 pm for CRJ Construction to begin the installation of a New Jersey American (NJAW) water main in the roadway. The roadway will be closed between Nassau Street and Chambers Street from 7 am to 6 pm on work days (Monday – Friday). The entire NJAW project on Bank Street is anticipated to be completed by Labor Day 2019.

On street parking will be prohibited during work hours from 7 am to 6 pm. Parking will be allowed in existing driveways; however, access to the street from driveways may be prohibited during work hours. It is recommended that residents move cars before 7 am if they are needed during the work day. Cars may return to Bank Street at end of each work day.

During work hours of 7:00 am to 6:00 pm, affected residents may park at one of the following locations described below and shown on the attached map:

- Monument Hall Parking lot, One Monument Drive, Princeton, NJ. Residents must display a yellow parking placard in their vehicles while parked in this lot.
- Metered parking spaces on the north side of Paul Robeson Place (westbound direction) between Chambers Street and Witherspoon Street. Residents must display the yellow parking placard in their vehicles while parked at this location.

For those who need to use the on-street parking on Paul Robeson Place or the off-street parking at Monument Hall, please contact Ms. Tiffany Smith, Engineering Inspector, at tsmith@princetonnj.gov to obtain a parking placard, which must be placed on the dashboard of the driver's side front windshield. Only one parking placard will be provided per dwelling unit.
