**IMPROVEMENTS TO LINDEN LANE AND SPRUCE STREET  
Project Update Notice No. 8  
February 24, 2020**

Dear Linden Lane and Spruce Street Neighborhood Property Owners and Residents:

For the week of February 24, 2020, Integrated Construction & Utilities of New Jersey (ICUNJ) will resume repairing/replacing sanitary sewer laterals for homes on Spruce Street. The next area of work will be on Spruce Street between **Pine Street** and **Maple Street** on both sides of the road. **This block on Spruce Street will be closed to all traffic Monday - Wednesday, 7:00 am - 6:00 pm. On-street parking in the work area will be prohibited while work is taking place.** Residents can park on surrounding streets during construction work hours. The road will reopen at the end of each work day.

The anticipated schedule for next week is to progress east on Spruce Street on a block-by-block basis until reaching Spruce Street Circle.

- Block between Maple Street and Linden Lane
- Block between Linden Lane and the Spruce Street Circle
- Then onto Linden Lane

If Princeton residents need to park overnight on the street, a temporary parking placard can be issued. Please contact Tiffany Smith, [tsmith@princetonnj.gov](mailto:tsmith@princetonnj.gov) to obtain a placard. Vehicle information will be given to parking enforcement and police to prevent tickets being issued.

The following work is expected to occur:

- ICUNJ will repair/replace individual sewer laterals in the roadway
- Each lateral will be disconnected for a period of time while the existing lateral is being repaired/replaced. Notices will be left on doors to homes anticipated being worked on the following day.
- ICUNJ will install a cleanout outside your home/structure and/or at the ROW line. It is recommended that the homeowner or representative be present or available during lateral repair/replacement.

Despite our best efforts to notify service providers, we advise that there will most likely be disruptions to garbage collection and recycling when work is taking place. Please report a missed trash pickup via SeeClickFix, or report a missed recycling pickup to Mercer County Improvement Authority (contact information for both on page 3). In cases of an emergency, the contractor can accommodate all emergency vehicles into a work zone. Access for services and deliveries within

the construction limits shall be maintained at all times during construction. If special accommodations are required, please advise us at your earliest convenience.

Ian Baker, Construction Engineer, is the main point of contact. Ian Baker and Tiffany Smith, Inspector, will be on-site daily while the contractor is working to observe the work. A project contact list is provided on the next page of this notice.

We will send out regular notifications by email regarding the project progress, changes to access, etc. These notices will also be posted on the project website at: <https://www.princetonnj.gov/resources/improvement-of-linden-lane-nassau-street-to-hamilton-avenue-and-spruce-street>.
