## IMPROVEMENTS TO LINDEN LANE AND SPRUCE STREET Project Update Notice No. 11 June 29, 2020

Dear Linden Lane and Spruce Street Neighborhood Property Owners and Residents:

We hope you and your families have been well during these last few months. Beginning the week of July 6, 2020, Integrated Construction & Utilities of New Jersey (ICUNJ) will resume repairing / replacing sanitary sewer laterals in the following order of streets:

- Remainder of Spruce Street;
- Linden Lane between Nassau Street and Spruce Street;
- Maple Street, north of Spruce Street.

While construction is underway, each roadway section will be closed to all traffic Monday - Friday, 7:00 am - 6:00 pm. On-street parking in the work area will also be prohibited while work is taking place. Residents should park on surrounding streets during construction work hours. The road section will be open at the end of each work day and on the weekends.

If your sanitary sewer lateral is being repaired / replaced, you will experience a period of time when your sewer is disconnected. You will receive a notice at least one day before the work is to take place. A new cleanout (inspection port) will be installed at your home/structure and/or at the right of way line. It is recommended that the homeowner or representative be present or available during lateral repair/replacement.

ICUNJ has provided the following schedule for the completion of the project:

- 1. Finish remaining sanitary sewer lateral work
- 2. Replace sanitary sewer mains under roadway (Spruce Street side of 73-75 Moran, in front of 125 Spruce Street, starting near 39 Linden Lane to Linden Lane/Hamilton Avenue intersection)
- 3. Install cast in place liner in select sanitary sewer mains along entire length of Spruce Street
- 4. Make storm sewer inlet and manhole repairs
- 5. Replace curb and sidewalks (end of July)
- 6. Mill and pave roadway (mid August)
- 7. Install pavement striping and signage
- 8. Restore grass / landscape areas adjacent to new improvements. Please note, tree replacement will be completed as a future tree planting project undertaken by the Municipal Arborist.

If you need to park overnight on the street, a temporary parking placard can be issued. Please contact Tiffany Smith, <a href="mailto:tsmith@princetonnj.gov">tsmith@princetonnj.gov</a>, to obtain a placard. Vehicle information will be given to parking enforcement and police to prevent tickets being issued.

Despite our best efforts to notify service providers, we advise that there will most likely be disruptions to garbage collection and recycling when work is taking place. Please report a missed trash pickup via SeeClickFix, or report a missed recycling pickup to Mercer County Improvement Authority (contact information for both on page 3). In cases of an emergency, the contractor will accommodate all emergency vehicles into a work zone. Access for services and deliveries within the construction limits shall be maintained at all times during construction. If special accommodations are required, please advise us at your earliest convenience.

Ian Baker, Construction Engineer, is the main point of contact. Ian Baker and Tiffany Smith, Inspector, will be on-site daily while the contractor is working to observe the work. A project contact list is provided on the next page of this notice.
