**IMPROVEMENTS TO LINDEN LANE AND SPRUCE STREET
Preconstruction Neighborhood Meeting on June 3, 2019 from 7:00 pm to 9:00 pm**

Dear Residents and Interested Neighbors,

We invite you to attend a neighborhood preconstruction meeting on Monday, June 3, 2019 at 7:00 pm in the Main Meeting Room located at One Monument Drive, Princeton, New Jersey 08542 for the Improvements to Linden Lane and Spruce Street construction project.

Maple Street (Nassau to Spruce), Moran Avenue (Nassau end) and Pine Street residents have been included in this invitation; however, construction activities are not currently planned for your roads but traffic flow will be disrupted when Spruce Street work is occurring at these intersections.

Princeton staff from the Engineering Department, the Sewer Operating Committee, and the Police Department will present the details about planned improvements on Spruce Street, Linden Lane, Maple Street, and Moran Avenue including the following:

- Replacement and / or installation of sections of storm drain piping
- Reconstruction or repair of storm drainage inlets and manholes
- Lining of sanitary sewer pipes
- Replacement of sanitary sewer pipe and sanitary sewer pipe laterals
- Removal of some street trees
- Resetting of curbs, replacement of concrete sidewalk, and reconstruction of driveway aprons
- Milling and resurfacing of roadway pavement
- Replacement of roadway traffic signs and installation of pavement markings, including new bicycle boulevard pavement markings and signage
- Coordination with PSE&G for gas main service replacements within a portion of the project area

Princeton's contractor, Integrated Construction and Utilities (ICUNJ) of Edison, New Jersey, will provide an overview of the six-month construction schedule, expected start date, planned roadway closures, and storage of construction materials and equipment. Residents will have the opportunity to ask questions of staff and the contractor, to review the project plans, and discuss your specific concerns regarding this project.

Extensive planning efforts have been made to minimize disruption to you during construction. On-street parking in the work area will be prohibited while work is taking place; we will provide

advance notification when this will occur. In general, we ask that you relocate your vehicle out of your driveway when work is occurring on your block to minimize the number of times you need to enter the work zone. This is for both your safety and the contractor's safety. When this relocation is requested, we will work with you to identify alternate places to park.

Despite our best efforts to notify service providers, we advise that there will most likely be disruptions to garbage collection and recycling when work is taking place; please contact the Department of Public Works at 609-688-2566 to report a missed pickup. In cases of an emergency, the contractor can accommodate all emergency vehicles into a work zone. If you require special accommodations, please advise us at your earliest convenience.

Tejal Patel, P.E., Assistant Engineer, is the project manager and main point of contact. Tiffany Smith, Inspector, will be on-site daily while the contractor is working to observe the work. A project contact list is provided on the next page of this notice for your use. To facilitate ease of communication regarding the project, please contact jredeyoff@princetonnj.gov to be added to the project email list. We will send out regular notifications by email regarding the project progress, changes to access, etc. These notices will also be posted on the project website at <https://www.princetonnj.gov/resources/improvement-of-linden-lane-nassau-street-to-hamilton-avenue-and-spruce-street>.

Residents are advised that there will a 5-year moratorium for road openings after the final roadway pavement is installed. If you are planning on making underground utility upgrades, in addition to sanitary sewer already included in the project, we recommend that you contact your service provider very soon so that the upgrades can be completed before we replace your sidewalks and pave the roadway. Contact information for the providers is included on the attached contact list.
