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**IMPROVEMENTS TO LINDEN LANE AND SPRUCE STREET
Project Update Notice No. 23
October 01, 2021**

Dear Linden Lane and Spruce Street Neighborhood Property Owners and Residents:

On **Monday, October 4, 2021**, weather permitting, Black Rock Enterprises, LLC will continue the sanitary sewer main replacement in the following areas:

- **Linden Lane between Spruce Street and Nassau Street going upstream; The section of main to be replaced will be from Spruce Street intersection to the manhole at the top of the hill (near 39 Linden & 40 Linden),**
- **Linden Lane between Spruce Street and Hamilton Street going upstream; The section of main to be replaced will be from the Hamilton Street intersection manhole at the bottom of the hill (near 76½ Linden & 89 Linden);**

We ask that you minimize the use of toilets and sinks, and activities such as laundry, dishwashing and showers during the specified work hours. **Laterals are being temporarily connected to the new main; they will be replaced from the property line to the main once the sewer main replacement has been completed.**

While construction is underway, each roadway section, on a block-by-block basis, will be closed to all traffic Monday - Friday, 7:00 am - 6:00 pm. **On-street parking in the work area will also be prohibited while work is taking place.** Residents should park on surrounding streets during construction work hours. **Please be advised that on street parking will become INCREASINGLY LIMITED as more construction activities take place concurrently.** The road section will be open at the end of each work day and on the weekends.

If Princeton residents need to park overnight on the street, a temporary parking placard can be issued. Please contact Tiffany Smith, tsmith@princetonnj.gov, to obtain a placard. Vehicle information will be given to parking enforcement and police to prevent tickets being issued. Sidewalk detours will be installed while work is taking place. Pedestrians are advised to avoid sidewalk construction zones and use alternative routes.

Garbage and recycling service providers have been notified of the restart of construction. Despite our best efforts, we advise that there will most likely be disruptions to garbage collection and recycling when work is taking place. Please report a missed trash pickup via SeeClickFix, or report a missed recycling pickup to Mercer County Improvement Authority (contact information for both on page 3). In cases of an emergency, the contractor can accommodate all emergency

vehicles into a work zone. Access for services and deliveries within the construction limits shall be maintained at all times during construction. If special accommodations are required, please advise us at the earliest convenience.

Ian Baker, Construction Engineer, is the main point of contact. Tiffany Smith, Engineering Inspector, will be on-site daily while the contractor is working to observe the work. A project contact list is provided on the next page of this notice.

We will send out regular notifications, by email regarding the project progress, changes to access, etc. as the work resumes. These notices will also be posted on the project website at <https://www.princetonj.gov/238/Linden-Lane-Spruce-Moran-Avenue-Maple>.
