Walsh, Esq., counsel for the Fair Share Housing Center ("FSHC"), in response to the court having issued a decision on March 8, 2018, establishing the fair share housing obligations for Princeton and West Windsor Township ("West Windsor"); and Mr. Walsh having requested that the spreadsheets used by Richard Reading, Special Master, to calculate the fair share obligations for Princeton and West Windsor be released to all counsel in this matter; and Jeffrey Serrenian Esq., counsel for Princeton and West Windsor, the remaining municipalities in the Mercer County Municipal Group, having submitted a letter to the court joining in Mr. Walsh's request for Mr. Reading's spreadsheets; and the court finding that it is appropriate for Mr. Reading to release the workbook spreadsheets he prepared for determining the fair share Prospective Need obligation of Princeton and West Windsor, and the workbook spreadsheets he prepared for determining the Gap Present Need obligations for Princeton and West Windsor;

IT IS on this 14th day of March, 2018, **HEREBY ORDERED** that:

1. Mr. Walsh's letter request is granted. Mr. Reading shall release the spreadsheets of the Prospective Need and Gap Present Need used to determine the Mount Laurel affordable housing obligations for Princeton

and West Windsor to all counsel by Monday, March 19, 2018.

2. Mr. Reading shall provide the spreadsheets electronically to all counsel of record at email addresses they provide to him by March 16, 2018.
