

NOTICE TO BIDDERS

Notice is hereby given that the Municipality of Princeton will receive sealed bids for the:

PLACEMENT AND REMOVAL OF SOLID WASTE DUMPSTERS for 2017.

Contract documents may be examined and obtained at the office of the Department of Public Works / Princeton Sewer Operating Committee, located at Monument Hall, One Monument Drive, Princeton, New Jersey 08540, weekdays between the hours of 9:30 A.M. and 4:00 P.M.

Bids may be submitted by mail or in person and will be received by the **Municipal Clerk, Municipality of Princeton, Witherspoon Hall, 400 Witherspoon Street, Princeton, New Jersey 08540 until 11:00 A.M. on November 23, 2016**, at which time they will be publicly opened and read. Bids received after this time will be disqualified.

All bids shall be prepared on approved bid forms that shall be submitted in a sealed envelope to Municipal Clerk, Municipality of Princeton, Witherspoon Hall, 400 Witherspoon Street, Princeton, N.J. 08540. The envelope shall bear the name and address of the bidder as well as the name of the bid submitted: BID FOR THE PLACEMENT AND REMOVAL OF SOLID WASTE DUMPSTERS for 2017.

Each bid must be accompanied by a bid security in the amount of 10% of the bid price or \$20,000, whichever is less. Said security shall be in the form of a certified check, cashier's check or bid bond, payable to the Municipality of Princeton.

Bids must also include the following documents:

1. Statement of Contractor Qualifications
2. Non-Collusion Affidavit
3. Ownership Disclosure Statement
4. Surety Guaranty
5. Certification of Investment Activities in Iran
6. Business Registration Certificate

No bid may be withdrawn within sixty days after the date set for bid opening.

The Municipality of Princeton reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to waive any informalities as deemed to be in the best interest of the Municipality of Princeton.

Bidders are advised that they must comply with the provisions set forth in the New Jersey Public Law, Chapter 127 PL1975 (N.J.A.C. 17:27), which was enacted into law on June 23, 1975. This Law relates to discrimination in connection with certain public contracts and supplements the "A Law Against Discrimination" approved April 6, 1945 (PL 1945 C169), and the

State of New Jersey Public Disclosure Law (Public Laws of 1977).
