

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE
EXTENSION OF THE QUAKER ROAD
PATHWAY FROM THE UPDIKE
FARMSTEAD TO MERCER COUNTY
BRIDGE #330.2 AND APPROPRIATING THE
SUM OF \$90,000.00 THEREFOR.**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Princeton as follows:

1. Section 11-12 of the “Code of the Township of Princeton, New Jersey, 1968”, which establishes no-parking regulations, is amended with regard to said regulations on the east side of Alexander Street and shall read as follows:

Alexander Road. East side, beginning at a point 340 feet from the northerly line of Faculty Road and proceeding therefrom to a point four hundred seventy-six feet from said northerly line of Faculty road, beginning again at a point five hundred forty-five feet from the northerly line of Faculty Road and proceeding therefrom a point five hundred seventy-seven feet from said northerly line of Faculty Road; [and finally] beginning at a point **one thousand two hundred fifty two** feet from the northerly line of Faculty Road and proceeding therefrom to a point **one thousand four hundred [thirty-six] twenty five** feet from said northerly line of Faculty Road and finally beginning again at a point sixteen hundred and ninety five feet from the northerly line of Faculty Road and proceeding therefrom to a point one thousand seven hundred and ninety feet from said northerly line of Faculty Road.

2. Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 39:4-8, the Office of Township Engineer, under seal, thereby certifies to the Township Committee that this additional no-parking designation and the erection of regulator and warning signs to affect the above designated additional no-parking areas are in the interest of safety and conform to the current standards prescribed by the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices for Streets and Highways, as adopted by the New Jersey Commissioner of the Department of Transportation.

3. Regulatory and warning signs shall be erected and maintained to effect the above-designated no-parking areas.

4. This Ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication, as proved for by law.
