### **Three important updates related to construction of the Arts and Transit Project**

#### **Weekend and weekday mid-day substitute bus service to run between Princeton and Princeton Junction Stations**

NJ TRANSIT has advised that on the weekends of July 27-28 and Aug. 3-4 buses will replace the rail shuttle service between Princeton and Princeton Junction Station due to construction of the new Princeton Station.

In addition, NJ TRANSIT has advised that beginning Monday, July 29, and continuing through Friday, Aug. 2, buses will replace rail shuttle service between Princeton and Princeton Junction Station from approximately 9:20 a.m. until 3:30 p.m. each day.

During these times, NJ TRANSIT buses will provide alternative service for customers. Buses will depart from locations near the rail platform at both Princeton Junction and Princeton stations.

#### **University Place lane shifts**

Beginning the evening of Monday, July 29, and continuing to the morning of Thursday, Aug. 1, there will be overnight roadwork in University Place between the hours of 8 p.m. and 5 a.m., when underground utility construction will occur on University Place near the Princeton Station buildings. University Place will be open for two-way traffic during these hours, but it will alternate onto one lane at a time in the work area. Princeton Police will be on site to provide traffic control.

There will be additional roadwork in University Place in the same area, also with one lane of through traffic at a time, on Saturday, Aug. 3, between the hours of 8 a.m. and 3:30 p.m.

#### **Taxi stand location change**

The location of the taxi stand on University Place at Princeton Station will be relocated as of Monday, July 29. Taxis will be available from a new location adjacent to the station, in the meter parking lot. Signage will direct passengers to this new location.
