IMPORTANT NOTICE REGARDING MERCER ROAD WORK

The installation of the two new sewer services on Mercer Road was successfully completed on Wednesday, May 21st. Top Line Construction Corp., the contractor for this project, together with our police and the inspectors from SOC and Engineering worked long hours to accomplish this. We appreciate everyone's patience in tolerating the extended work hours that allowed the road to be reopened the following morning.

The remainder of the work on Mercer Road is planned to be completed beginning June 4th, weather permitting. This work will consist of driveway apron resurfacing, installation of belgian block curbing at Hale Drive and a small portion of concrete curb on Mercer Road at Quaker Road, just east of the Stony Brook bridge, leveling and final surfacing of the section of the Mercer Road between Quaker Road to the Lawrence Township line (Phase II). The work is expected to be completed by June 14th, weather permitting. When this work is proceeding, Mercer Road will be closed to through traffic from Province Line Road to Quaker Road between the hours of 9 am to approximately 7 pm. You will receive additional notice prior to the work proceeding.

Provisions will be made for continued services such as brush collection, mail delivery, garbage, recycling pick-up and school bussing. The road will be reopened to full two-way traffic at the end of each work day and will remain open until the start of next work day.

The repair of Quaker Road in the area of the D&R Canal is planned to be done after the Mercer Road work is completed. You will receive additional notice prior to the Phase II work proceeding.
