IMPROVEMENT OF BANK STREET NEIGHBORHOOD MEETING NOTICE – MAY 27, 2015

Dear Bank Street Neighborhood Residents:

The Municipality of Princeton is designing improvements to Bank Street for construction in 2015 - 2016. You are invited to attend a neighborhood design meeting, chaired by Mayor Liz Lempert, on Wednesday, May 27 at 7:00 pm in the Main Meeting Room located at One Monument Drive (former Borough Hall Council Room) to discuss this project. If you are unable to attend this meeting, please email comments to dstockton@princetonnj.gov at your earliest convenience. Comments will be evaluated and incorporated into the design as appropriate.

The Engineering Department has identified the following improvements to be made as part of this project:

- Repair of the sanitary sewer main and replacement of sewer lateral from the main to your building.
- Repair and extension of storm sewer piping and inlets where necessary.
- Replacement of the existing water main and services. *This work is to be completed by New Jersey American Water Company in conjunction with the municipality's project.*
- Replacement of roadway curbing with concrete curbing.
- Replacement of sidewalks.
- Repair and reconstruction of the roadway.
- Removal and replacement of existing trees.

We understand that Bank Street residents are interested in placing the overhead utilities underground, and we are working with the utility companies to determine the viability and cost of such an undertaking. Current Board of Public Utilities (BPU) regulations require that the benefitted Bank Street and Nassau Street property owners pay for this work. The municipality would consider creating a 10-year assessment for repayment of the cost.


Please complete the enclosed Drainage Form to assist us in locating your sump pump and roof drain discharge points. Where possible, the municipality will connect these into an underground piped storm sewer system to remove the potential for icing and ponding conditions. The form may be returned by mail to the address above, by fax, or by email to dstockton@princetonnj.gov.

Residents are advised that the Municipality will be imposing a 5-year moratorium on any street openings once the work is completed. Therefore, if you plan to upgrade or install new utility services

such as gas, water, electric, etc., you should contact the respective utility company at this time to make the necessary arrangements. A telephone list for the various project contacts is provided on the next page of this notice for your use.


