3.3 Sanitize buckets not in use. Please prepare sanitize buckets every morning prior to starting food prep. \* 1/2 capful of bleach per 1/2 gallon of water will make a proper solution. Store all soiled and wet cloth rags in these buckets to use for cleaning surfaces and preventing bacterial growth. This solution can also be used to sanitize knives, equipment etc.

35 When cooling food please ensure it is put in the walk-in refrigerator to properly cool. Cooling food any other way will allow for bacterial growth or contamination.
