Nassau Streetscape Public Meeting
November 22, 2016 at 7:00 – 9:00 pm

The community is invited to attend a public meeting, chaired by Mayor Liz Lempert, on Tuesday, November 22, 2016 to review and discuss the draft Nassau Streetscape Design Standards. The meeting will be held in the Main Meeting Room of the Municipal Building located at 400 Witherspoon Street from 7:00 to 9:00 PM.

Looney Ricks Kiss (LRK), Princeton's consultant, has been working in collaboration with the Princeton Merchants Association, Princeton Historic Preservation Commission, Princeton University, and the municipality of Princeton to formulate a draft menu of design treatments for the pedestrian space (from curb to building) on Nassau Street. Design features under consideration include benches, sidewalk materials, bike racks, newspaper boxes, tree wells, landscaping, signage and garbage / recycling bins. While there is no capital project currently planned to install the proposed design features, the municipality of Princeton is seeking funding to begin the implementation of the streetscape on Nassau Street.

Public comments received during the June 18, 2016 interactive open house have been incorporated into the draft design standards available at <http://www.princetonnj.gov/Streetscapes/16005-Draft-Design-Guidelines-161005.pdf>. We invite you to review these draft standards and provide comments at the November 22nd meeting.
