Dear Township Of Princeton,

As you may be aware, Williams operates a natural gas transmission pipeline in your community known as Transcontinental Gas Pipe Line (Transco), which transports much of the natural gas consumed in your region. In January you should have received a letter from Williams announcing the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC) had agreed to enter into a pre-filing environmental review of the proposed Leidy Southeast Expansion Project.

#### **Informational Meeting**

Williams invites you to attend an informational meeting for potentially affected landowners in Princeton Township whose property is located along the proposed route of the pipeline. This meeting will be held on Thursday, February 28, 2013 at 7:00 pm in the Main Meeting Room at the Princeton Municipal Building, located at 400 Witherspoon Street in Princeton, 08540. This meeting is being held in advance of our upcoming public open houses and is specifically designed to help educate you about the FERC process. We are very early in the engineering design phase of the the proposed project. While we will have some preliminary maps for review, these maps are intended for discussion purposes only and are subject to change based on environmental and civil survey information as well as input from stakeholders.

Representatives of the various technical disciplines involved in the project will be present to answer questions and provide additional information about the project.

#### **Project description**

The project is a proposed expansion of the Transco Mainline and Leidy systems in Pennsylvania and New Jersey. The proposed project scope includes new pipeline facilities, additional compression, and facility modifications. In your area, Williams anticipates the project will require construction of approximately 6.36 miles of new 42-inch pipeline or "loop" (new

pipeline laid parallel to existing lines) in Montgomery Township in Somerset County, and Princeton Township in Mercer County, NJ. Additional information regarding the project can be found on the project website at [www.williams.com/leidysoutheast](http://www.williams.com/leidysoutheast)

### **The regulatory process**

Before Williams can modify its facilities, the company must obtain a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity from the FERC. The final facility design, location and other details of the proposal have not yet been determined and a formal application has not yet been filed with the FERC. The environmental pre-filing review is a step in the information gathering process.
