Dear Community Leader,

As you may be aware, Williams operates a natural gas transmission pipeline in your community known as Transcontinental Gas Pipe Line (Transco), which transports much of the natural gas consumed in your region. You are receiving this letter to keep you informed of possible project activities in your area and to solicit your input and support.

Project description

Williams has received requests from natural gas distribution companies and suppliers to increase the natural gas deliveries by November 2015. We are in the preliminary stages of designing an expansion of our existing pipeline facilities to meet these requests. The name of the proposed project is Leidy Southeast Expansion Project and is being developed to serve the existing demand for natural gas as well as the projected growth in demand along Transco's path in the Mid Atlantic.

The overall project consists of approximately 28.75 miles of 42-inch pipeline, four sections, in the following counties: Luzerne and Monroe Counties in Pennsylvania, Hunterdon, Somerset and Mercer Counties in New Jersey.

In your area, Williams anticipates the project will require the construction of 6.36 miles of 42" pipe in Mercer County (Princeton Township) & Somerset County (Montgomery Township), NJ referred to as the Skillman Loop. Our project update newsletter that was recently mailed to all landowners is enclosed.

The regulatory process

Before Williams can modify its facilities, the company must obtain a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity from the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC). The final facility design, location and other details of the proposal have not yet been determined and a formal application has not yet been filed with the FERC; however, we have requested that FERC initiate a pre-application environmental review of the project. FERC has assigned a pre-filing docket number, PF13-5, for this project. We anticipate filing our formal Natural Gas Certificate 7(c) application with FERC in the fourth quarter of 2013.

Open houses

Before we finalize the project design, we want to give all interested parties an opportunity to review the study area and provide suggestions. Your input is important to us. The comments gathered during this planning phase will help to shape our final proposal.

Williams has scheduled the following open house meetings in New Jersey. Preliminary maps will be available for review and comment. These maps are subject to change based on environmental and civil

survey information as well as input from stakeholders. Representatives from the various technical disciplines involved in the project will be on hand to answer questions and provide additional information about the project.
