

ORDINANCE #2017-4

AN ORDINANCE BY THE MUNICIPALITY OF PRINCETON REGULATING NO PARKING ON THE NORTH SIDE OF RUSSELL ROAD BETWEEN WINANT ROAD AND HUN ROAD, AND AMENDING THE “CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PRINCETON, NEW JERSEY, 1968”.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of Princeton as follows:

Section 1. Section 11-12 of the “Code of the Township of Princeton, New Jersey 1968” (Code) establishing parking prohibited at any time is hereby amended as follows:

Sec. 11-12. At any time.

No person shall park any vehicle on any of the following streets or parts of streets at any time:

Russell Road, north side from the western most intersection with Winant Road to a point eight hundred forty feet westerly.

Section 2. The appropriate No Parking signs shall be posted to implement the requirements of this Ordinance.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication and shall become part of the new Princeton Code once completed and adopted.

The purpose of the ordinance is to amend the no parking zone on the north side of Russell Road adjacent to The Hun School of Princeton between the westernmost intersection with Winant Road and the intersection with Hun Road in order to improve safety, in accordance with endorsements from the Princeton Police Department and the Traffic Safety Committee.
