

AN ORDINANCE BY THE MUNICIPALITY OF PRINCETON TO ESTABLISH NO PARKING ON THE FIRST AND THIRD WEDNESDAY MORNINGS OF THE MONTH IN THE WITHERSPOON JACKSON NEIGHBORHOOD TO ACCOMMODATE STREET CLEANING OPERATIONS AND TO AMEND THE "CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF PRINCETON, NEW JERSEY, 1974" AND THE "CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PRINCETON, 1968"

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of Princeton as follows:

Section 1. Section 19-22 (c) of the "Code of the Borough of Princeton, New Jersey, 1974" (Code) establishing no parking zones on certain streets on designated weekdays to facilitate street sweeping is hereby amended as follows:

Sec. 19-22 No parking zones

(c) No parking between 9:00 A.M. and 11:00 A.M. on certain weekdays.

(1) No person shall park any vehicle between the hours of 9:00 A.M. and 11:00 A.M. upon any of the following streets or parts of streets on the weekdays as set forth below in order to permit street sweeping of these streets:

Birch Avenue, north side, from Bayard Lane to Witherspoon Street on the first Wednesday of every month.

Clay Street, south side, from John Street to Witherspoon Street on the first Wednesday of every month.

Green Street, south side, from John Street to Witherspoon Street on the third Wednesday of every month.

John Street, east side, from Maclean Street to the northerly terminus at Community Park South on the first Wednesday of every month.

John Street, east side, from Paul Robeson Place to Maclean Street

on the third Wednesday of every month.

Leigh Avenue, north side, from Bayard Lane to Witherspoon Street on the first Wednesday of every month.

Lytle Street, north side, from John Street to Witherspoon Street on the first Wednesday of every month.

MacLean Street, south side, from John Street to Witherspoon Street on the third Wednesday of every month.

Quarry Street, north side, from John Street to Witherspoon Street on the third Wednesday of every month.

Race Street, east side, from Leigh Avenue to the northerly terminus at Community Park South on the first Wednesday of every month.

Section 2. Chapter 11 of the “Code of the Township of Princeton, New Jersey, 1968” is amended by rescinding Section 11-19.3 in its entirety as follows:

Section 3. The appropriate no parking signs shall be posted to implement the requirements of this Ordinance.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication and shall become part of the new Princeton Code once completed and adopted.
