

**AN ORDINANCE BY THE TOWNSHIP OF  
PRINCETON ESTABLISHING A LICENSING FEE  
FOR "POTENTIALLY DANGEROUS" DOGS &  
AMENDING THE "CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF  
PRINCETON, NEW JERSEY, 1968**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Princeton as follows:

1. Sec. 6-9.13 of the "Code of the Township of Princeton, New Jersey 1968" which establishes a licensing fee for "potentially dangerous dogs" is amended to read as follows:

Sec. 6-9.13 Fee for potentially dangerous dog license.

Each person who shall own, possess, keep or harbor any potentially dangerous dog or dogs shall obtain an annual license for each dog and shall have the same registered and numbered with the Township Clerk, and for each such license shall pay the sum of [one hundred (\$100.00)] seven hundred (\$700.00) dollars as a license fee for each and every potentially dangerous dog. Said license fee shall be in lieu of the license fee required pursuant to Sec. 6-2 of this Code.

2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication as provided by the law.

Additions in text are indicated by underlining, deletions by [brackets], except that underlined catchwords are not necessarily additions.

The foregoing ordinance was introduced at a meeting of Princeton Township Committee held on August 13, 2007 and will be further considered for final passage after a public hearing thereon at a meeting of said Township Committee to be held at the Princeton Township Municipal Complex, 400 Witherspoon Street on September 10, 2007 which begins at 7:00 p.m.
