


Curbside Organics Program: Princeton Composts costs \$65. You receive a kitchen collector, compostable bags, a green cart with wheels and a tight fitting lid. Pick up is every Wednesday. Princeton residents only. To sign up, go to: princetonnj.gov or call: 688-2566
