

### **Juvenile Report –November 2014**

#### **Juveniles Petitioned to Family Court**

A 16 year old male was charged with Possession of a Controlled Dangerous Substance and Use/Being Under the Influence of CDS when he was discovered smoking Marijuana in Quarry Park.

A 17 year old female was charged with Disorderly Conduct after she went to a classmate's home with a group of teenagers, some of whom were reported to be carrying branches and a baseball bat, called the girl out of her home and threatened to assault her. Two additional 17 year old females were charged with Hindering Apprehension during the same event after they were hostile toward responding officers, refused to provide their names and lied during the police investigation.

A 17 year old female was charged with Disorderly Conduct and Obstruction of the Administration of Law after she engaged in a physical fight in a public place which she initiated by posting an online video challenging two other girls to fight her. She was non-compliant with the patrol officer who responded to the 911 fight in progress call, yelled at him in close proximity to his face, called him a vulgar name and acted in an aggressive manner.

A 17 year old female was charged with Disorderly Conduct after she engaged in a physical fight in front of a crowd of people, causing someone to call 911.

A 17 year old boy and a 15 year old boy were charged with Possession of a Controlled Dangerous Substance, Possession of Drug Paraphernalia and Underage Possession of Alcohol after they were located in Grover Park with Marijuana.

#### **Juveniles Afforded a Station House Adjustment**

A 16 year old male was taken into custody for Underage Possession of Alcohol and Tampering with Public Records after being observed by a plain clothes Detective purchasing alcohol with a fictitious driver's license.

#### **Curbside Warnings**

A 17 year old male was given a curbside warning after a classmate felt harassed by him sending a general Twitter message which she believed was directed at her.

#### **Juvenile Family Crisis**

A father reported having family issues with his 17 year old daughter including that she charged \$3,000 on his credit card without his authorization. Service referrals were provided.

A 17 year old female called the police after having an argument with her father. Upon de-escalation, a referral was made to Mobile Response and Stabilization Services.


November 21<sup>st</sup>- SNB conducted a safety/stranger danger presentation at the Cherry Hill Nursery School.

# Total Arrests 2014












# Dispatch Overtime



- ❖ Cpl. Solovay and K-9 Harris continue to attend the New Jersey State Police K-9 Training Academy, Patrol Class # 15, in order to be a certified Patrol K-9 Team. Training includes obedience, agility, evidence searching, tracking, building clearing, and apprehension.
- ❖ On Sunday, November 2, 2014, Cpl. Solovay and K9 conducted an explosives sweep in Princeton, specifically in the Central Business District, for the Princeton Half Marathon. The Mercer County Sheriff's Office K-9 Unit assisted with the sweep.
- ❖ On Wednesday, November 19, 2014, Cpl. Solovay and K9 Harris conducted two police K-9 demonstrations at Princeton Charter School. The first demonstration was the lower school, which consisted of kindergarten through 4<sup>th</sup> grade students. The second demonstration was for the upper school, which consisted of 5<sup>th</sup> grade through 8<sup>th</sup> grade students. Attendees were provided with a lecture on the uses and benefits of police service dogs, an overview of the Princeton Police K-9 program, and were also given a demonstration on various police K-9 skills including- obedience, agility, drive, and explosives detection.
- ❖ On Thursday, November 20, 2014, Cpl. Solovay and K9 Harris conducted an explosives sweep at Alexander Hall at the request of Princeton University Department of Public Safety and the United States Marshal's Service for the visit of United States Supreme Court Justice, Elena Kagan.
- ❖ On Monday, November 24, 2014, Cpl. Solovay and K-9 Harris attended a Police K-9 Use of Force and Case Law Update provided by the New Jersey State Police. K-9 Teams in attendance received training on the Attorney General Use of Force Guidelines as it pertains to the police service dog as well as updates from applicable case law.


