The Princeton Planning Board will conduct a public hearing to determine whether certain real property located at 1-10 Franklin Avenue and specifically designated as Lots 2, 26 and 27 in Block 21.04 on the Tax Map of Princeton (the “study area”), or a portion thereof, meets the requirements for, and should be designated under the Local Redevelopment and Housing Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:12A-1, et seq., as a non-condemnation redevelopment area, such that any redevelopment area determination shall not authorize the municipality to exercise the power of eminent domain to acquire any property in the study area.
