

Ordinance #2020-44

AN ORDINANCE BY THE MUNICIPALITY OF PRINCETON REGULATING SPEED LIMITS ON TERHUNE ROAD AND AMENDING THE “CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PRINCETON, NEW JERSEY, 1968.”

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of Princeton as follows:

Section 1. Section 11-2 of Chapter 2 of the “Code of the Township of Princeton, New Jersey, 1968,” insofar as it regulates speed limits on Terhune Road, is hereby amended as follows (additions are underlined; deletions are [bracketed]):

Sec. 11-2. Speed limits.

(a) Thirty-five miles per hour:

[Terhune Road - Van Dyke Road, both directions, between Harrison Street and Snowden Lane.]

(e) Twenty-five miles per hour:

Terhune Road, both directions, between Mount Lucas Road and Meadowbrook Drive.

(f) Thirty miles per hour:

[Terhune Road, both directions, between U.S. Route 206 and Mount Lucas Road.]

[Terhune Road - Van Dyke Road, both directions, between Harrison Street North and Meadowbrook Drive.]

Section 2. The appropriate speed limit signs shall be posted to implement the requirements of this ordinance.

Section 3. All ordinances and resolutions or parts thereof inconsistent with this ordinance are repealed.

Section 4. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct, and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion thereof.

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication and shall become part of the new Princeton Code once completed and adopted.

The foregoing ordinance was introduced at a meeting of the Mayor and Council of Princeton held on November 16, 2020 and will be further considered for final passage after a public hearing thereon at a meeting of said Mayor and Council to be held on December 7, 2020 beginning at 7:00 p.m.

The purpose of the ordinance is to lower the speed limit on Terhune Road between Harrison Street North and Meadowbrook Drive from thirty miles per hour to twenty-five miles per hour in accordance with endorsements from the Engineering Department and Princeton Police Department.
