Water Tank Repair in Princeton, New Jersey

Dear Princeton Residents,

New Jersey American Water is preparing to make emergency structural repairs to a ground level water storage tank located off Mt. Lucas road in Princeton. This project represents a critical investment for the company in support of our goal to provide customers with safe, reliable water service and must be completed to maintain the structural integrity of the water tank.

Our contractor, US Tank Painting, Inc. began work on January 11 and is scheduled to be completed by early May, weather permitting. Work hours will be from 8 a.m. to 6 p.m., Monday through Friday. Work outside of these hours is not expected unless required to maintain project schedule.

As with any construction project, some noise will be unavoidable with this project, especially during the weeks of January 18 - 29 and February 8 - 19. During these weeks, residents may notice a dull hum generated from sandblasting equipment. Residents may also notice a slight decrease in water pressure for the duration of this project. There should be no impacts to local traffic.
